

What is the Central Access Point (CAP)?

The CAP line is a hotline that is a single point of contact for emergency shelters and homeless assistance programs. Call one number to check for space in shelters all over Cincinnati.

We assist everyone who needs shelter, individuals and families.

Intake Specialists make placements into programs over the phone.

CAP is operated by Strategies to End Homelessness, a United Way Agency Partner.
